Temporary Suspension of Honorary Country (Cameroon) Ambassador

Whereas CCLP Worldwide been the global custodian and promoter of the EDUCATION CHARTER; needs a wholesome climate of integrity and responsibility to promote and carry out its global operations;

It is incumbent on HONOURARY AMBASSADORS, as the official representatives of CCLP Worldwide to operate with the highest sense of decorum and responsibility and observe the code of conduct adopted by CCLP Worldwide.

The information of the Honorary Country (Cameroon) Ambassador Mr. Bilongo Bolo Serge to the Office of International Chairman, to the effect of his being accused by many Ambassadors of CCLP Worldwide for misusing the name and reputation of our organization and to impress them (Ambassadors) to get the invitation letter and visa for personal work and emailing them for some dubious work unrelated to CCLP Worldwide core mission and objectives, calls for great concern;

In other to protect the name and integrity of CCLP Worldwide, I hereby pass the order for temporary suspension of Mr. Bilongo Bolo Serge for all the position of CCLP Worldwide with immediate effect and intimation for this be sent to Mr. Serge for his clarification and reply as to why disciplinary action should not be taken against him.

Hony. Chairman Dr Elvis C Enyioko will take final decision on the case of Mr. Serge In the interim, in my capacity as the Vice Chairman of International Council of CCLP Worldwide, I have requested the International Secretariat to suspend the recognition of Mr. Bilongo Bolo Serge, pending the conclusion of investigations into the origin and veracity of these allegations against this person.
