Contribution of the organization to the work of the United Nations:

CCLPW had actively participated in RIO+20 Summit and also developed RIO+20 Logo in Hindi language. Seventh issue of the magazine "the Education Charter" covered article on Rio+20. The CCLPW representative addressed UNCAC Implementation Review Group meeting at Vienna on 20TH June 2012 and submitted its view to Chair. It was invited as Observer in 69th Session of UNESCAP Legislative Session. The United Nations ESCAP organized Regional Implementation meeting to discuss the outcome of RIO+20 at United Nations Conference Center, Bangkok. Dr Vinod Singh, Main Representative of CCLPW To UN ECOSOC has joined this meeting as Designated Facilitator of UNESCAP for Major Group - NGO. The Joint statement of Major Group was presented by Dr Vinod Singh on 23rd April and the emphasis for sustainable development was recommended to UNESCAP for further action. The committee had the task of selecting speakers for 2nd July program held on UN head quarter.
