

Resolution of the International Council of CCLP Worldwide

On the Initiation of Public Consultation for Education Charter International (ECI) 2026+

Resolution No.: CCLP-IC/ECI/2026-03

Date: 16th Dec' 2025

Preamble

WHEREAS, the Education Charter International (ECI) was originally developed between 1999 and 2003 as a global call to action for ethical, inclusive, and socially responsible education, and was promoted through the platform of CCLP Worldwide;

AND WHEREAS, over the past two decades, education systems globally have undergone profound transformation arising from technological change, societal shifts, economic disruption, and emerging ethical challenges;

AND WHEREAS, the International Council of CCLP Worldwide has determined that a structured renewal and reconstruction of the Education Charter International is necessary to ensure its continued relevance, integrity, and global applicability;

AND WHEREAS, CCLP Worldwide has prepared Education Charter International (ECI) 2026+ as a renewed framework and has resolved to place the same in the public domain through an open and transparent consultation process;

NOW THEREFORE, the International Council hereby resolves as follows:

Resolution

1. Approval of Public Consultation

The International Council of CCLP Worldwide hereby formally approves and authorises the initiation of a Global Public Consultation on Education Charter International (ECI) 2026+, to be conducted over a defined consultation period as notified by CCLP Worldwide.

The consultation shall invite feedback from governments, universities, schools, TVET institutions, civil society organisations, educators, learners, and citizens worldwide.

2. Status of the Existing Education Charter

During the consultation period, the existing foundational Education Charter International (1999–2003) shall be:

- Preserved as a foundational and historical reference document; and
- Placed in an archived, non-operative status for the purposes of endorsement and institutional adoption.

The foundational Charter shall not be withdrawn or invalidated, but shall remain part of the institutional and historical record of CCLP Worldwide.

3. Suspension of New Endorsements

With immediate effect and for the duration of the public consultation period:

- No new endorsements, adoptions, or institutional alignments under the existing Education Charter International shall be accepted; and
- All expressions of interest shall be redirected to the ECI 2026+ Public Consultation process.

This measure is adopted to ensure clarity, transparency, and procedural fairness during the transition.

4. Archiving of Existing Offices and Titles

In order to maintain institutional neutrality and avoid conflicts of representation during the consultation process, the International Council hereby resolves that:

- The formal ranks, titles, and designations of office bearers associated with the existing Charter framework shall be archived for the duration of the consultation;
- Such archiving does not imply censure, removal, or retrospective invalidation of service rendered; and
- Office bearers shall continue to be acknowledged in historical records and institutional archives.

5. Formation of a New Governance Structure Post-Consultation

Upon completion of the public consultation and formal adoption of the final ECI 2026+ framework, the International Council shall:

- Constitute a new governing and advisory structure aligned with the renewed Charter;
- Define revised roles, titles, and responsibilities consistent with ECI 2026+; and
- Ensure that governance reflects principles of transparency, diversity, competence, and global representation.

6. Authority to Implement

The International Council hereby authorises:

- The Secretariat of CCLP Worldwide to publish this resolution on official platforms;
- The initiation and management of the public consultation process; and
- All necessary administrative and procedural actions required to give effect to this resolution.

7. Nature of the Resolution

This resolution is adopted as an institutional governance measure and does not create legal, regulatory, or contractual obligations for any external party.
